USA Cycling Masters National Championships: Clarke takes 3rd (age 35-39), Grimm finishes 5th place in Criterium(age 30-34), & Martin is 6th in Road Race- others finish well at Masters Nationals Championship in Louisville, KY



Louisville, KY - July 4th: USA Cycling Masters National Championships (July 4)

The USAC Masters Road National Championships wrapped up with the men's 30-49 criterium contests on a wet Fourth of July. The final four masters road Stars-and-Stripes jerseys were awarded following fierce battles on the half-mile course around the infamous infield at Churchill Downs. In all nearly 1,000 competitors age 30 and over fought for national titles in the road race, time trial and criterium over the last week in Louisville.

In what may have been the most exciting race of the event, three riders, John Puffer, Chris DeMarchi, and Andrew Clarke (Panther/RGF/Felt) held off a talented field in the 35-39 age division. The excitement didn't end there however, coming down to a photo finish to decide the national championship as Puffer was able to edge Demarchi by only inches for the Stars-and-Stripes.

Jeremy Grimm of the Panther/RGF presented by Felt Bicycles Cycling Team finished 5th place at the USAC Masters National Criterium Championship 30-34 age division on the raining slick course.
