### Chernosky captures bronze medal on the penultimate day of the 2010 USA Cycling Masters Road National Championships in IN.



**LOUISVILLE, KY. August 7, 2010:**

Dave Chernosky of the Cleveland Clinic - RGF Sports presented by Felt Bicycles, rode to a bronze medal on the penultimate day of the 2010 USA Cycling Masters Road National Championships as criterium racing got underway on a riverfront, four-corner course in Jeffersonville, Ind.

“Well, I learned a good lesson finally after about 20 years. Rest is good. Took a week off to let my ribs heal a bit more. I can breath again. Bobby (Martin) and I went down to Masters Nationals in Louisville. Different age groups, but nice traveling together. We started balls to the wall for the first 5 laps. Thought I was going to drop out, in fact. Single file. Then after 10 laps my legs loosened up and I felt real good. A lot of solo and double breakaway attempts but our field was strong and nothing was staying away. Had a chance to win. Fought it out for the last 5 laps. Was at the front with one to go. Around the back side, the guy who won surged (Jamie Paolinetti). Went through the last two tight turns at full speed in third. Came out with 200 meters and the first two times I tried to jump my chain skipped. Then it stuck and I almost passed second. Held on for third. Nice podium, although I was disappointed because I was so close and felt so good. Might not get another chance like that,” stated bronze medalist Dave Chernosky.
